

Announcement of the Launch of the Low-Carbon Hydrogen Model Town Pilot Project in Chita City, Aichi Prefecture

Toagosei Co., Ltd. (Hidenori Kobuchi, Representative Director, President & COO) has been participating since last fiscal year in the feasibility study for the “Low-Carbon Hydrogen Model Town Project” planned by Aichi Prefecture. We are pleased to announce that, based on the results of the feasibility study, we will commence the pilot project.

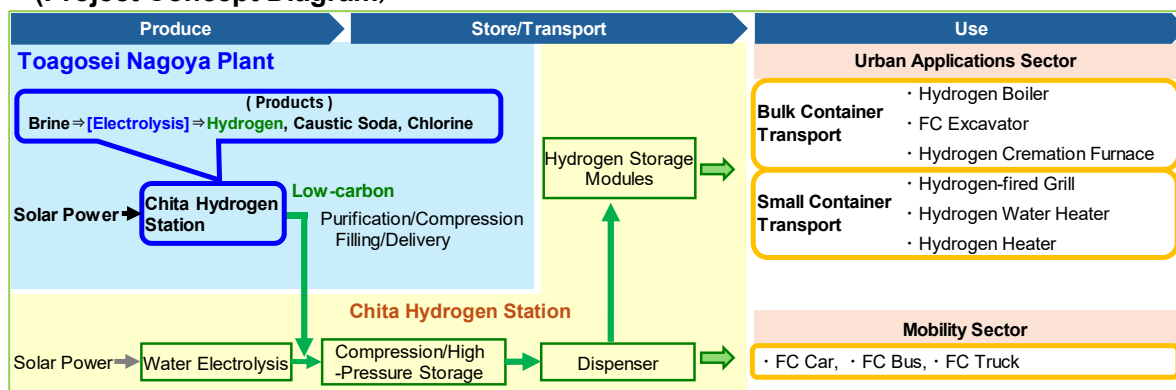
Aichi Prefecture, together with 17 companies and other organizations including Toagosei, will collaborate to undertake the “Low-Carbon Hydrogen Model Town Pilot Project in Chita City”(hereinafter, the “Project”).

Using the hydrogen station in Chita City as a hub, the Project aims to efficiently supply low-carbon hydrogen—produced and procured by leveraging local resources—to various end-users in urban sectors. This will be achieved by utilizing the existing LPG distribution network and newly developed types of hydrogen containers (see Project Concept Diagram).

Leveraging hydrogen production through brine electrolysis at our plant in Nagoya City, we will supply low-carbon hydrogen generated with renewable electricity, thereby contributing to the Project.

Furthermore, the Project was selected under the Ministry of the Environment, Japan’s public call for proposals titled “FY2025 Model Construction and Pilot Project of Hydrogen Supply Chains Derived from Renewable Energy, etc., to Enhance Cost Competitiveness.”
